

## **Pump Troubleshooting** Find the bad actors

## Assemble a team to find your bad actor pumps:

- Engineers
- Management
- Operators
- Maintenance technicians
- Pump vendor representative

## Use these tips to find the pumps that need attention:

- 1. Start with a list of the MTBF numbers. Focus on pumps that fall on the low end of the MTBF, such as the bottom 25%.
- 2. Consider adding to the list any pumps that see few hours of operation, but still fail frequently.
- 3. Estimate the cost of production loss for each of the pumps in question.
- 4. Create charts showing frequency of outage, cost of repairs, and production loss.
- 5. Determine which equipment tag numbers are the worst performers that need to be addressed<sup>1</sup>.
